ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

GOODS VEHICLES RESTRICTED ZONE ON GLOUCESTER ROAD, CAUSEWAY BAY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 8 January 2016, the western kerbside lane of Gloucester Road from a point about 10 metres north of its junction with Sugar Street to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction will be designated as a restricted zone for goods vehicles 24 hours daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

(a) picking up or setting down passengers; or

(b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone from 7.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight daily designated (except goods vehicles loading/unloading) on the above road section will be rescinded.
