

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)

**MTR TSIM SHA TSUI STATION NORTHERN SUBWAY
AND ENTRANCE MODIFICATION WORKS**

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF AN OPEN PLACE
AT THE JUNCTION OF NATHAN ROAD AND HAIPHONG ROAD, AND
SECTIONS OF THE FOOTPATHS OF NATHAN ROAD AND HAIPHONG ROAD**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 7 April 2016 (the ‘Order’), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary closure of part of the open place at the junction of Nathan Road and Haiphong Road, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered TNS/G01/0001/3; and
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of the footpath of Nathan Road between its junction with Haiphong Road and a point about 40 metres north of the junction, and the section of the footpath of Haiphong Road between Nathan Road and Lock Road, as delineated and shown in yellow and green respectively on the Plan numbered TNS/G01/0001/3,

during the period from 1 May to 31 December 2016 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the MTR Tsim Sha Tsui Station Northern Subway and Entrance Modification Works. A description of the works to be carried out, the area of the open place and the sections of the footpaths to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered TNS/G01/0001/3 (the ‘Plan’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:-

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the open place and the footpaths or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the open place and the footpaths affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the open place and the footpaths or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.
