ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

GOODS VEHICLES RESTRICTED ZONES ON NGA YING CHAU STREET TSING YI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 15 April 2016, the following road sections in Tsing Yi will be designated as restricted zones for goods vehicles from 7.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Nga Ying Chau Street from a point about 56 metres north of its junction with Tsing King Road to a point about 66 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Nga Ying Chau Street from a point about 33 metres north of its junction with Tsing King Road to a point about 38 metres north of the same junction; and
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Nga Ying Chau Street from a point about 81 metres north of its junction with Tsing King Road to a point about 91 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all goods vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
