

It is hereby notified that tenders are invited for the **provision of Cleansing Services to Ma On Shan and Nai Chung Recreation Areas in Ma On Shan Country Park for the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (Tender Reference: AFCD/MOSNC/06/16)**. The contract will be for a duration of 24 months commencing on 1 July 2016.
