

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in triplicate are invited for the **‘Tender for Berth Licence Agreements of Designated Waste Paper Berths adjacent to Chai Wan, Rambler Channel and Tuen Mun Public Cargo Working Areas (Tender Ref: PASTR2016-06)’**. The Berth Licence Agreements are for a period of 60 months, tentatively from 1 August 2016 to 31 July 2021, and are for 16 designated waste paper berths located adjacent to 3 Public Cargo Working Areas (PCWAs) as follows:—

Chai Wan PCWA (10 berths)

Rambler Channel PCWA (4 berths)

Tuen Mun PCWA (2 berths)

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the ‘Chairman, Central Tender Board’, and must be deposited in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box situated at the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on 6 May 2016 (Friday). Late tenders will not be considered.

The tender documents are obtainable from the Marine Department Headquarters counter on 21st Floor (Room 2121), Harbour Building, 38 Pier Road, Central, Hong Kong.

Tenderers must attach to each tender a bank draft in a sum equal to two times of the monthly licence fee of the Berth Licence Agreement tendered for as a pledge of the *bona fides* of their tenders. The deposit will be returned to the unsuccessful tenderers without interest.

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administration Region does not bind itself to accept the highest tender or any tender, and reserves the right to negotiate with any tenderer about the terms of the offer.

Details of the award of the Berth Licence Agreements will be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette and made available on the Internet.
