

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(Notice under section 18)

LIFT AND PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY SYSTEM

BETWEEN KWAI SHING CIRCUIT AND HING SHING ROAD, KWAI CHUNG

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close permanently sections of the existing carriageway and central medians/traffic islands; and temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands and pedestrian crossings within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. RDO6175TB-GZ0001 and RDO6175TB-GZ0002 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 8235 published on 30 October 2015 and 6 November 2015. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 15 May 2017, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageway and central medians/traffic islands to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished; and from 15 May 2017 to 14 May 2018, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands and pedestrian crossings to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the construction of a lift tower with three lifts and associated footpath adjacent to Hing Shing Road, the construction of an elevated walkway with two columns to connect the above lift tower and associated footpath adjacent to Kwai Shing Circuit, the construction of footpath at Ko Fong Street and other ancillary works.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands and pedestrian crossings on 5 May 2017.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims served under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
