

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON  
YUK WAH STREET, WONG TAI SIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 8 May 2017 to 30 September 2017, the following road sections on Yuk Wah Street in Wong Tai Sin will continue to be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily to facilitate the construction of Shatin to Central Link:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Yuk Wah Street from a point about 30 metres east of its junction with Wan Wah Street to a point about 120 metres east of the same junction; and
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Yuk Wah Street from a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Wan Wah Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
