A plan showing the approximate boundaries of the four regions is attached at Annex A. The four agreements are expected to commence in September 2024 with agreement periods of 36 months each.

If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted or 'extreme conditions after super typhoon' is announced by the Government, within two hours before the tender closing time and/or remains hoisted beyond the tender closing time, or the Director of Housing announces the closure of the Housing Authority Headquarters Building due to unforeseen circumstances and the Housing Authority Headquarters Building remains closed for any duration, the tender closing time and date will be postponed to 10.00 a.m. on the first working day (excluding Saturday) after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is lowered, or 'extreme conditions after super typhoon' has/have been ceased to be in force, or the Housing Authority Headquarters Building is reopened. For the avoidance of doubt, the tender closing time will remain unchanged if black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted or 'extreme conditions after super typhoon' is lowered or cancelled, or the Housing Authority Headquarters Building is reopened, two hours or more before the tender closing time on the tender closing date.
