ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)  
(Notice under section 8(2))

PWP ITEM NO. 6721TH  
WIDENING OF YUEN LONG HIGHWAY BETWEEN  
LAM TEI AND SHAP PAT HEUNG INTERCHANGE

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary for Transport proposes to execute the road works as shown on Plans Nos. HyD/YLH/1000 to 1007 (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) widening of approximately 4.5 km long of the existing Yuen Long Highway between Lam Tei and Shap Pat Heung Interchange (the Highway) from dual 2-lane to dual 3-lane;
- (ii) provision of a 1 m wide road margin and a 3.65 m wide hard shoulder along the slow lane of the Highway;
- (iii) modification of the existing slip roads and interchanges;
- (iv) modification of the existing highway structures including elevated roads, pedestrian subways and box culverts;
- (v) permanent closure of sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths;
- (vi) construction of carriageways, a footpath and an elevated road as shown on the Plans; and
- (vii) ancillary works including road rehabilitation, slope, landscaping, drainage and street lighting works, erection of noise barriers and construction of retaining walls.
