**ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)**  
**(Notice under section 8(2))**

**DEEP BAY LINK, AND**

**PWP ITEM NO. 6721TH (PART)**  
**WIDENING OF YUEN LONG HIGHWAY**  
**BETWEEN LAM TEI AND SHAP PAT HEUNG INTERCHANGE**  
**(SECTION BETWEEN LAM TEI AND TAN KWAI TSUEN)**

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary for Transport proposes to execute the road works as shown on Plans Nos. (the 'Plans') 22913/P/53/701, 22913/P/53/702, 22913/P/53/703, 22913/P/53/704, 22913/P/53/705, 22913/P/53/706, 22913/P/53/707, 22913/P/53/708, 22913/P/53/709, 22913/P/53/710, 22913/P/53/711, 22913/P/53/712, and 22913/P/53/713 and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of an approximately 5.4 km long dual 3-lane trunk road (the proposed Deep Bay Link) linking the proposed Shenzhen Western Corridor from Ngau Hom Shek to the existing Yuen Long Highway;
- (ii) construction of an interchange at Lam Tei;
- (iii) widening of approximately 2 km long of the existing Yuen Long Highway between Lam Tei and Tan Kwai Tsuen from dual 2-lane to dual 3-lane;
- (iv) construction of a grade-separated interchange at Ha Tsuen connecting the proposed Deep Bay Link with Ha Tsuen;
- (v) provisions for connection to future carriageways;
- (vi) modification of existing roads and highway structures;
- (vii) permanent closure of sections of existing tracks and construction of replacement tracks;
- (viii) temporary closure of sections of existing carriageways/tracks, and reconstruction of sections of existing carriageways/tracks; and
- (ix) ancillary works including road rehabilitation, slope, landscaping and drainage; construction of the associated retaining walls, noise barriers, a helipad, a weighing station and a compound for storage of equipment necessary for road operation; and provision of police observation platforms along road sides.
