## LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

## ORDER THAT A SOLICITOR BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING ISAAC RAHMAT SADIQ

In accordance with section 12(2) of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that a Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal, on 20 November 2002, found Isaac Rahmat Sadiq guilty of nine complaints on his own admission. The complaints were that he was in breach of Principles 4.12, 6.04 and 12.05 of the Hong Kong Solicitors' Guide to Professional Conduct, Rules 2(a), (c), (d) and (e) of the Solicitors' Practice Rules and Rule 10(1) of the Solicitors' Account Rules

The Tribunal has made an order that unless Mr. Sadiq pays up the outstanding Counsel fees in the total sum of HK\$104,800 by 5.00 p.m. on or before 27 January 2003 (the 'Deadline Date'), he be suspended from practising as a solicitor with effect from the Deadline Date for 18 months or until the date of his full payment of the outstanding Counsel fees, whichever is the earlier.

Mr. Sadiq has not paid up the outstanding Counsel fees by the Deadline Date and the order has come into effect.
