ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

PWP ITEM NO. 6718TH
IMPROVEMENT TO TUNG CHUNG ROAD
BETWEEN LUNG TSENG TAU AND CHEUNG SHA

NOTICE is hereby given that under section 11(2)(b) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Chief Executive in Council has authorized the works and the use as described in G.N. 6907 published on 1 November 2002 and 8 November 2002, with modifications as shown on Plans Nos. MW6718TH-GZ0001A and MW6718TH-GZ0002B (the 'Modification Plans') and described hereunder. The Modification Plans have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The modifications involve:—

- (i) raising of the level of the proposed new section of Tung Chung Road to allow for uninterrupted pedestrian and vehicular movements along the catchwater road (Plan No. MW6718TH-GZ0001A); and
- (ii) addition of proposed access near the proposed roundabout at the junction of the proposed new section of Tung Chung Road and South Lantau Road (Plan No. MW6718TH-GZ0002B).
