PWP ITEM NO. 6731TH—IMPROVEMENT TO CASTLE PEAK ROAD  
BETWEEN KA LOON TSUEN AND SIU LAM

*Amendments under section 7*

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works under sections 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Acting Permanent Secretary of the Environment, Transport and Works (Environment and Transport) proposes to amend the works originally described in Plans Nos. MW6731TH-GZ0001 and MW6731TH-GZ0002 and the scheme annexed thereto, which plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 3861 published under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) on 28 June 2002 and 5 July 2002. The proposed amendments are shown on Amendment Plan No. MW6731TH-GZ0006 (the 'Amendment Plan') and described in the Amendment scheme annexed thereto, which Amendment Plan and amendment scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed amendments is as follows:—

- (i) provision of a car park at Tai Lam Kok;
- (ii) deletion of the proposed noise barriers and noise enclosures; and
- (iii) revise the limit of works area to suit the realignment of the proposed viaduct from Tai Lam Kok to Siu Lam.
