LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

ORDER THAT A BARRISTER BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING  
MR. RODERICK GRAHAM MURRAY

In accordance with section 37A of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that on 13 May 2005 a Barristers Disciplinary Tribunal found the complaints against Mr. Roderick Graham Murray of misconduct proved.

The complaints were that Mr. Roderick Graham Murray acted contrary to the provisions of paragraphs 4, 6(b), 6(c), 70 and 133 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

The Tribunal ordered that:—

- (1) Mr. Roderick Graham Murray be censured for Complaint (A)(1);
- (2) He be suspended from practising as a barrister for a period of 3 months for Complaint (A)(2);
- (3) He be suspended from practising as a barrister for a period of 6 months for Complaint (A)(3);
- (4) He be suspended from practising as a barrister for a period of 6 months for Complaint (B);
- (5) The suspensions mentioned in (2), (3) and (4) above are to run concurrently;
- (6) This Order is to take effect from the date of expiration of the appeal period. If there is an appeal, this Order will be suspended pending the outcome of the appeal.

The Tribunal also ordered that the costs of and incidental to these proceedings be paid by him on a full indemnity basis to be taxed if not agreed.
