

PROTECTION OF WAGES ON INSOLVENCY ORDINANCE (Chapter 380)

(Notice of payment and reasons therefore
given pursuant to section 16(1A))

Notice is given pursuant under section 16(1A) of the Protection of Wages on Insolvency Ordinance (Chapter 380) that I have made an *ex gratia* payment of \$7,500.00 out of the Protection of Wages on Insolvency Fund under section 16(1)(a)(ii) of that Ordinance to MUHAMMAD Saleem and ALI Moazam ('the Employee') the former employee(s) of TSUI Choi Yau trading as Ken Yau Construction Engineering Co. ('the Employer') of Flat 8, 14/F, Shing Yuk House, Tin Shing Court, 3 Tin Ching Street, Tin Shui Wai, New Territories, the reasons for the payment being that it appeared to me that the Employer had failed to pay wages, or wages in lieu of notice, or severance payment, or all or any of them due to the Employee and the Employer would, but for the existence of section 6(2)(a) of the Bankruptcy Ordinance (Chapter 6), be liable to have a bankruptcy petition presented against him.
