RETROFITTING OF NOISE BARRIERS ON TSEUNG KWAN O ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Acting Permanent Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works (Transport) proposes to execute the road works as shown on Plans Nos. HMW6765TH-GZ0001 and HMW6765TH-GZ0002 (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) erection of a segment of approximately 4-metre high and 90-metre long noise barrier on the northern side of the flyover carrying the Tseung Kwan O Road eastbound traffic near Tsui Hon House of Tsui Ping South Estate, Lam Tin;
- (ii) erection of two segments of approximately 7-metre high cantilevered noise barrier with length of approximately 350 metres and 100 metres along the footpath and the central divider of the eastbound carriageway of Tseung Kwan O Road near Tsui Heng House to Tsui Chung House of Tsui Ping South Estate, Lam Tin;
- (iii) erection of a segment of approximately 7-metre high and 530-metre long cantilevered noise barrier along the central divider of Tseung Kwan O Road near Hing Tin Estate and Hong Wah Court, Lam Tin;
- (iv) application of low noise materials onto an approximately 370-metre long section of the existing concrete carriageway of Tseung Kwan O Road near Hing Tin Estate and Hong Wah Court, Lam Tin;
- (v) temporary closure and resurfacing of sections of the existing elevated carriageways, at-grade carriageways and footpaths; and
- (vi) ancillary works including utilities diversion, street lighting, traffic aids, landscaping, geotechnical and drainage works.
