

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in five copies are invited for the **provision of Information Technology (IT) Services for the Judiciary of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region**. The services include:—

- Transition Services;
- Ongoing Support and Maintenance Services relating to application systems, network infrastructure, office automation etc.; and
- Other IT Services relating to current and future IT service requirements.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer). Tenderers are reminded to submit the technical and price information respectively in two separate envelopes. Tenders must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated in the lift lobby on the Lower Ground Floor of the Central Government Offices (East Wing), 20 Lower Albert Road (at its junction with Garden Road), Central, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon (Hong Kong time) on Friday, 18 May 2007. Late tenders will not be accepted.

In case a tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above or a black rainstorm warning is valid for any duration between 9.00 a.m. (Hong Kong time) and 12.00 noon (Hong Kong time) on the tender closing date, the tender closing date will be extended to 12.00 noon (Hong Kong time) on the first working day (excluding Saturday) of the following week.
