ELECTORAL AFFAIRS COMMISSION (NOMINATIONS ADVISORY
COMMITTEES (LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL)) REGULATION
(Chapter 541 sub. leg. C)

Pursuant to sections 2(2), 2(3), 2(5), 3(3), 3(4), 5(4), 5(5) and 6(3) of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Nominations Advisory Committees (Legislative Council)) Regulation, the following notices are given:—

I. Appointment of Nominations Advisory Committees (Legislative Council)

The following legal practitioners are each appointed as a Nominations Advisory Committee (Legislative Council) ('NAC(LC)') for the period from 11 April 2008 to 4 August 2008, both dates inclusive, in relation to the Legislative Council Election which consists of elections in respect of the five geographical constituencies and the 28 functional constituencies, all to be held on 7 September 2008 with the same nomination period from 19 July 2008 to 1 August 2008:—

Mr. HO Bing-kwan,
Mr. LUI Kit-ling, and
Mr. WONG Ching-yue, S.C.

II. Periods in which each NAC(LC) must perform its functions

Each NAC(LC) is to perform during the following periods the functions specified under section 3(1) of the said Regulation:—

- (a) Between 11 April 2008 and 21 July 2008, to perform functions on applications by prospective candidates to seek advice and to complete the same by 21 July 2008.
- (b) Between 19 July 2008 and 4 August 2008, to perform functions on applications by Returning Officers to seek advice and to complete the same by 4 August 2008.

III. Periods in which applications for advice from the NACs(LC) are to be made

- (a) Applications under II(a) must be made in the specified form and lodged with the Chief Electoral Officer, either in person or by post or by facsimile, to be received by him between 11 April 2008 and 18 July 2008, both dates inclusive.
- (b) Applications under II(b) must be in writing and lodged with the Chief Electoral Officer, either in person or by post or by facsimile, to be received by the Chief Electoral Officer between 19 July 2008 and 2 August 2008, both dates inclusive.
