

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)
(Notice under section 8(2))

WIDENING OF CARRIAGEWAY AT MAN KAM TO ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. HK-MKT-001 (the 'Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plan and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) widening and realignment of a section of the existing carriageway and provision of associated footpaths;
- (ii) construction of a pedestrian underpass;
- (iii) temporary closure and reconstruction of a section of the existing carriageway;
- (iv) permanent closure of a section of the existing footpath and conversion of it into carriageway; and
- (v) ancillary works including geotechnical works, landscaping, drainage, lighting and utility diversion works, and installation of traffic lights.

The Plan and scheme may be inspected by members of the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—
