(Amendment to Plan and Scheme under section 7)

(Notice under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance
as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation)

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to amend the sewerage works originally described in the scheme (the 'Scheme') and the Plans No. 60022017/L701 to 60022017/L703 and Resumption Plan No. YLM7097 (sheets 1 and 2) (the 'Plans'), and the previous amendment sewerage works as described in the amendment scheme (the 'first Amendment Scheme') and Plans No. 60022017/L701A to 60022017/L703A (the 'first Amendment Plans'). The Plans and Scheme were referred to in G.N. 6607 published under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation on 26 September 2008 and 3 October 2008. The first Amendment Plans and first Amendment Scheme were referred to in G.N. 3751 published on 19 June 2009 and 26 June 2009.

Take further notice that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the amendment sewerage works as shown on the Plans No. 60022017/L701B to 60022017/L703B (the 'Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto (the 'Amendment Scheme'), which Amendment Plans and Amendment Scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the amendment sewerage works is as follows:—

- (i) revisions of the limit of works areas as shown on the Amendment Plans; and
- (ii) no resumption of land for the sewerage works is required.

The Amendment Plans and Amendment Scheme may be inspected by members of the public, free of charge, at the following locations and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—
