UPGRADING OF SAN WAI SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS

(Amendment to Plan and Scheme under section 7)

(Notice under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance
as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation)

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to amend the sewerage works originally described in the Scheme and Plan No. 60041298/G101 and Resumption Plan No. YLM7129a referred to in G.N. 3750 published under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation on 19 June 2009 and 26 June 2009.

Take further notice that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the amendment sewerage works as shown on Plan No. 60041298/G101A (the 'Amendment Plan') and Resumption Plan No. YLM7129b (the 'Amendment Resumption Plan') and described in the amendment Scheme annexed thereto, which Amendment Plan and Amendment Resumption Plan and Amendment Scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed amendments is as follows:—

- (i) revision of the limit of works area as shown on the Amendment Plan;
- (ii) revision of the limit of proposed land resumption of the Lots No. 518, 519, 520, 521, 524, 1250, 1255, 1256 and 1259 in D.D. 125 as shown on the Amendment Resumption Plan;
- (iii) addition of proposed land resumption of the Lots No. 525 and 526 in D.D. 125 as shown on the Amendment Resumption Plan; and
- (iv) change in area of proposed land resumption of the Lot No. 522 in D.D. 125 as shown on the Amendment Resumption Plan.
