AIRCRAFT ACCIDENT—INSPECTOR’S INVESTIGATION

Notice is hereby given that an Inspector’s Investigation is being conducted into the cause of the accident which occurred on 13 April 2010 whereby an Airbus A330 aircraft with registration B-HLL, operated by Cathay Pacific Airways with flight number CX 780 arriving from Surabaya, Indonesia, made an emergency landing at the Hong Kong International Airport.
