(Notification under section 5)

PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAMME ITEM NO. 5177DR
DREDGING AND RECLAMATION TO THE SOUTH-WESTERN COAST OF
SHEK KWU CHAU FOR THE
INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES PHASE 1 (IWMF—PHASE 1)

Notice is hereby given that the undertaking described in the Schedule below is proposed. Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over the foreshore and sea-bed so described may, by notice in writing delivered to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of two months from the date of this notice, object to the proposed undertaking. The notice of objection shall describe the interest, right or easement of the objector and the manner in which he alleges he will be affected.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 315 hectares of foreshore and sea-bed situated at the south-western coast of Shek Kwu Chau and between Shek Kwu Chau and Cheung Sha, Lantau Island as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered ISM2069b, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

- (i) Dredging of the sea-bed, construction of cofferdam/seawalls, breakwaters, berths and reclamation of a total area of approximately 16 hectares at the south-western coast of Shek Kwu Chau for the proposed IWMF—Phase 1 as delineated and shown stippled black on the plan, numbered ISM2069b, and
- (ii) Laying of a maximum of 4 submarine cables below the foreshore and sea-bed from the proposed reclaimed land near Shek Kwu Chau to Cheung Sha, Lantau Island.

The area of foreshore and sea-bed affected is shown on the plan on the next page for identification purposes only. The area is more particularly shown on the plan numbered ISM2069b above referred to.
