LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

ORDER THAT A BARRISTER BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING
WONG Hak Ming Derry

In accordance with section 37A(2) of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that on 28 June 2011 a Barristers Disciplinary Tribunal found three complaints against Mr. WONG Hak Ming Derry proved. The proven complaints were that Mr. WONG acted in breach of paras. 4, 6(b), 6(c), 131 and 133 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

The Tribunal ordered that:—

- (a) Mr. WONG be suspended from practising as a barrister for a period of six (6) months for the three complaints respectively from the date on which Mr. WONG reapply for his Practising Certificate. The period of suspension for the three complaints shall run concurrently;
- (b) In relation to each of the three complaints, the parties are to be at liberty to disclose this Order and the Tribunal's Statement of Findings to such person or persons as the Bar Council may designate;
- (c) Mr. WONG do pay the Bar Council's costs and incidental to the proceedings to be taxed by a Master of the Court of First Instance on a full indemnity basis.

The Order of the Tribunal dated 28 June 2011 was filed with the Registrar on 13 July 2011.
