I. Appointment of Nominations Advisory Committees (Legislative Council)

The following legal practitioners are each appointed as a Nominations Advisory Committee (Legislative Council) ('NAC(LC)') for the period from 27 April 2012 to 2 August 2012, both dates inclusive, in relation to the Legislative Council Election which consists of elections in respect of the five geographical constituencies and the 29 functional constituencies, all to be held on 9 September 2012 with the same nomination period from 18 July 2012 to 31 July 2012:-

II. Periods in which each NAC(LC) must perform its functions

Each NAC(LC) is to perform during the following periods the functions specified under section 3(1) of the said Regulation:-

- (a) Between 27 April 2012 and 19 July 2012, to perform functions on applications by prospective candidates to seek advice and to complete the same by 19 July 2012.
- (b) Between 18 July 2012 and 2 August 2012, to perform functions on applications by Returning Officers to seek advice and to complete the same by 2 August 2012.

III. Periods in which applications for advice from the NACs(LC) are to be made

- (a) Applications under II(a) must be made in the specified form and lodged with the Chief Electoral Officer, either in person or by post or by facsimile, to be received by the Chief Electoral Officer between 27 April 2012 and 17 July 2012, both dates inclusive.
- (b) Applications under II(b) must be in writing and lodged with the Chief Electoral Officer, either in person or by post or by facsimile, to be received by the Chief Electoral Officer between 18 July 2012 and 1 August 2012, both dates inclusive.
