- (a) The tenderer must be on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works confirmed in Group C under Roads and Drainage Category, or in the case of a joint venture tenderer, the lead participant or major shareholder in the joint venture must be on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works confirmed in Group C under Roads and Drainage Category; and
- (b) The tenderer, or any one of the participants/shareholders in a joint venture tenderer, must have completed at least one road construction contract involving vehicular concrete bridge, with awarded contract sum of not less than HK\$400 million, in or outside Hong Kong, within the past 10 years.

Contractors will be liable to have their names removed from the approved lists if they fail or refuse to implement an accepted tender.
