Expression of interest is hereby invited for the Main Engineering Infrastructure in association with the Proposed Developments at Area 56 in Tung Chung (Contract No. 20130375).

- (d) They must have met the 'minimum capital ratio requirement' with Employed Capital not less than 10% of Total Assets; and
- (e) They are not being restricted or suspended from tendering or removed from the Development Bureau's 'List of Approved Contractors for Public Works' when being considered for tender out.
