(Second Amendment to Plan and Scheme under section 7)  
(Notice under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation)  
Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution  
Control (Sewerage) Regulation)

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to further amend the sewerage works originally described in the scheme and the Plans Nos. 382828/WPCR/1.2/001 and 382828/WPCR/1.2/002, and Resumption Plan No. SKM8058e (the 'Plans') referred to in G.N. 688 published under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation on 8 February 2013 and 15 February 2013, amended by Amendment Plans Nos. 382828/WPCR/1.2/001A and Resumption Plan No. SKM8058f referred to in G.N. 6471 published under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation on 1 November 2013 and 8 November 2013.

Take further notice that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the amendment sewerage works as shown on Second Amendment Plans Nos. 382828/WPCR/1.2/001B and Resumption Plan No. SKM8058g (the 'Second Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, which Second Amendment Plans and amendment scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the amendment sewerage works is as follows:—

- (i) revisions of the limit of works area as shown on the Second Amendment Plans; and
- (ii) deletion of the proposed land resumption of:—  
Lot Nos. 325 S.A (Portion), 325 S.B (Portion), 325 RP (Portion), 326 S.A (Portion), 326 S.B (Portion) and 327 RP (Portion) all in D.D. 401;  
Lot Nos. 25 S.C ss.1 RP (Portion) and 25 S.C ss.2 (Portion) all in S.D. 9 as shown on the Second Amendment Plans.
