## PWP ITEM NO. 4345DS— NORTH DISTRICT SEWERAGE STAGE 2 PART 2A (PART)— VILLAGE SEWERAGE IN YIM TSO HA, SHA TAU KOK, NEW TERRITORIES

(Notice under section 18 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation)

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, I have made an order under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (hereinafter referred to as 'the Ordinance') as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation that the roads, footpaths and open space, or parts thereof within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. 382813/N9/YTH/1 (the 'Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, be temporarily closed. The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 620 published on 28 January 2011 and 2 February 2011. I have further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 15 April 2014 to 31 October 2016, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the affected roads, footpaths and open space, or parts thereof shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The sewerage works to be carried out on the affected roads, footpaths and open space, or parts thereof involve:----

- (i) Construction of approximately 550 metres of sewer and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan; and
- (ii) Ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement of roads, alleys, footpaths and open spaces.

A copy of the order and the Plan showing the affected roads, footpaths and open space, or parts thereof may be inspected by members of the public, free of charge, at the following locations and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—
