ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(Notice under section 8(2))

**PWP ITEM NO. 7785TH
TRUNK ROAD T2**

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. CEDD/GZ7785/001 to CEDD/GZ7785/006 ("the Plans") and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of a dual two-lane trunk road of approximately 3.0 kilometres (km) long between the South Apron of the former Kai Tak Airport and Cha Kwo Ling. Approximately 2.7 km of the trunk road is in the form of tunnel with associated pedestrian cross passages and emergency pedestrian walkways;
- (ii) construction of sections of at grade carriageways, depressed carriageways, central reserves and amenity areas;
- (iii) permanent closure and demolition of a section of the existing footpath and amenity area; and
- (iv) ancillary works including civil and structural engineering, drainage, landscaping, utilities, water supplies, electrical and mechanical, and building works; as well as the construction of a tunnel portal, traffic facilities for tunnel operation, a ventilation building and a temporary barging point.

The Plans and scheme may be inspected by members of the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—
