

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in six identical copies are invited for **Contract No. EP/SP/74/13—Provision of Services for Eastern District Community Green Station**. The services include setting up, management and maintenance of the Eastern District Community Green Station, conduct of environmental education activities and provision of recyclables collection services within the Eastern District. The service contract is of 3 years and is scheduled to commence in the 2nd quarter of 2015 for completion in the 2nd quarter of 2018.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference (Contract No: EP/SP/74/13) and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated in the lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon on Friday, 23 January 2015.
