VILLAGE SEWERAGE WORKS AT TAI WAN TO (PART),  
LONG TSAI TSUEN AND HUNG SHING YE

(Notice under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation)  
Ordinance as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution  
Control (Sewerage) Regulation)

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the sewerage works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. 60040941/LRP/6001A and Resumption Plan No. ISM2446b (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed sewerage works is as follows:—

- (i) Construction of approximately 2 200 metres of gravity sewer and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (ii) Construction of approximately 300 metres of twin pressurised mains and associated chambers within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (iii) Construction of 1 sewage pumping station at Hung Shing Ye within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (iv) Ancillary works including temporary closure, permanent closure and reinstatement of roads, alleys, footpaths and open space.
