UNIVERSAL ACCESSIBILITY PROGRAMME—  
PROVISION OF BARRIER-FREE ACCESS FACILITIES AT FOOTBRIDGE NO. HF145  
NEAR FENWICK STREET IN WAN CHAI DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. CE37/HF145/GZ/0001 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plan and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of three lifts at the existing footbridge No. HF145 near Fenwick Street in Wan Chai District;
- (ii) construction of elevated platforms and the associated columns to connect the proposed lifts in (i) with the existing footbridge No. HF145;
- (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageway into footpath and central divider;
- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing central divider into carriageway;
- (v) demolition and conversion of parts of the existing planters into footpaths and columns; and
- (vi) ancillary works including electrical and mechanical, drainage and lighting works.
