ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

STAGE 3 INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS FOR DEVELOPMENTS
AT THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE FORMER RUNWAY

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under sections 17(1)(a) and 17(1)(b) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and central medians/traffic islands, and to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and central medians/traffic islands, as well as to reclaim the Government foreshore and/or sea-bed within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. 60022408/S3/1.1 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 2789 published on 16 May 2014 and 23 May 2014. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 23 November 2015, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and central medians/traffic islands to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished; from 23 November 2015 to 22 November 2016, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and central medians/traffic islands to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period; and as from 23 November 2015, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the Government foreshore and/or sea-bed to be reclaimed, shall be extinguished.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the widening and re-alignment of Cheung Yip Street with associated footpaths and supporting underground structures, widening of Shing Cheong Road with associated footpaths and supporting underground structures, construction of central medians/traffic islands and pedestrian crossings, as well as other ancillary works.

The works to be carried out in association with this reclamation mainly involve the construction of an outfall.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected carriageways, footpaths and central medians/traffic islands, as well as the Government foreshore and/or seabed on 20 November 2015.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure or extinction.

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims served under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes.
