The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:----

- (i) construction of two lifts at the existing footbridge No. KF76 across Fung Tak Road near Lung Poon Street;
- (ii) construction of elevated platforms to connect the proposed lifts in (i) with the existing footbridge No. KF76;
- (iii) construction of a section of at grade footpath near Fung Tak Estate Community Centre;
- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing at grade footpath into the proposed lift near Lung San House;
- (v) demolition and conversion of the existing at grade planters into at grade footpaths;
- (vi) permanent closure and demolition of the ramps (including lower ramp, middle ramp and upper ramp) of the existing footbridge No. KF76 near Fung Tak Estate Community Centre;
- (vii) permanent closure and demolition of the ramps (including lower ramp and middle ramp) of the existing footbridge No. KF76 near Lung San House; and
- (viii) ancillary works including electrical and mechanical, drainage, landscape and lighting works.
