

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONE ON
PRINCE EDWARD ROAD WEST, KOWLOON CITY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 December 2015 to 14 December 2015, the southern kerbside lane of Prince Edward Road West westbound from its junction with Forfar Road to a point about 45 metres east of the same junction will continue to be temporarily designated a restricted zone 24 hours daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road section will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
