

ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ON  
FANLING HIGHWAY, TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 January 2016 to 30 June 2017, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily subject to a speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour:—

- (a) the section of Fanling Highway southbound from a point about 1 700 metres south of its junction with Jockey Club Road to a point about 95 metres north of its junction with the slip road leading to Hong Lok Yuen Road; and
- (b) the section of Fanling Highway northbound from a point about 220 metres north of its junction with Hong Lok Yuen Road to a point about 1 100 metres south of its junction with the slip road leading to Pak Wo road (Exit 7C).

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit of 100 kilometres per hour on the above sections of road will be temporarily rescinded.
