

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN  
SHUN YUNG STREET, HUNG HOM

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 January 2016 to 30 June 2016, the following road sections in Shun Yung Street in Hung Hom will continue to be temporarily designated restricted zone from 7.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight daily to facilitate the construction of Kwun Tong Line Extension:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Shun Yung Street from a point about 25 metres south of its junction with Pak Kung Street to a point about 45 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Shun Yung Street from a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Pak Kung Street to a point about 45 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
