

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

KWUN TONG LINE EXTENSION

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHUNG YEE STREET;
SECTIONS OF CHUNG HAU STREET, HAU MAN STREET,
FAT KWONG STREET AND SHEUNG LOK STREET,
A STAIRCASE NEAR THE JUNCTION OF FAT KWONG STREET
AND CHUNG HAU STREET, AND A FOOTPATH CONNECTING
FAT KWONG STREET AND CHUNG YEE STREET**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 6 January 2016 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary partial closure of Chung Yee Street, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered KTE/G02/0005/5, KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Chung Hau Street near its junction with Hau Man Street, and the section of Hau Man Street between its junction with Chung Hau Street and a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Chung Yee Street, as delineated and shown in red and green respectively on the Plans numbered KTE/G02/0005/5, KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of Fat Kwong Street between a point about 30 metres north of its junction with Sheung Lok Street and a point about 110 metres south of the junction, and the section of Sheung Lok Street between its junction with Fat Kwong Street and a point about 220 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow and dark blue respectively on the Plan numbered KTE/G07/0005/5;
- (IV) the temporary closure of the staircase near the junction of Fat Kwong Street and Chung Hau Street, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plans numbered KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5; and
- (V) the temporary partial closure of the footpath connecting Fat Kwong Street and Chung Yee Street, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plans numbered KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5,

during the period from 1 February to 30 June 2016 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Kwun Tong Line Extension. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads, the staircase and the footpath to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered KTE/G02/0005/5, KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5 (the 'Plans') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads, the staircase and the footpath affected by the Order on 15 January 2016.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads, the staircase and the footpath or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads, the staircase and the footpath affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads, the staircase and the footpath or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

The roads, the staircase and the footpath to be affected *Description of the works and the manner in which the roads, the staircase and the footpath will be affected*

- (a) Chung Yee Street, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered KTE/G02/0005/5, KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the covered walkway, the footbridge and the associated structures of the Kwun Tong Line Extension, and reinstatement works.
- (b) The section of Chung Hau Street near its junction with Hau Man Street, and the section of Hau Man Street between its junction with Chung Hau Street and a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Chung Yee Street, as delineated and shown in red and green respectively on the Plans numbered KTE/G02/0005/5, KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the footbridge and the associated structures of the Kwun Tong Line Extension, and reinstatement works.
- (c) The section of Fat Kwong Street between a point about 30 metres north of its junction with Sheung Lok Street and a point about 110 metres south of the junction, and the section of Sheung Lok Street between its junction with Fat Kwong Street and a point about 220 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow and dark blue respectively on the Plan numbered KTE/G07/0005/5. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the covered walkway, the footbridge and the associated structures of the Kwun Tong Line Extension, and reinstatement works.
- (d) The staircase near the junction of Fat Kwong Street and Chung Hau Street, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plans numbered KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5. The staircase will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station entrance and the associated railway facilities of the Kwun Tong Line Extension, and reinstatement works.
- (e) The footpath connecting Fat Kwong Street and Chung Yee Street, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plans numbered KTE/G03/0005/5 and KTE/G07/0005/5. Parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the covered walkway, the footbridge and the associated structures of the Kwun Tong Line Extension, and reinstatement works.

Personal Information Collection Statement
