SUPPLEMENTARY MEDICAL PROFESSIONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 359)

ORDER MADE BY THE OPTOMETRISTS BOARD

The Optometrists Board, after due inquiry held on 19 November 2015 in accordance with the Optometrists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation (Chapter 359, sub. leg. F), was satisfied that Mr. LAU Tak-ki (Registration No.: OP400034), being a registered optometrist (Part IV), disregarded and/or neglected his professional duties and responsibilities towards Ms. KEUNG Yuen-fong ('the Patient') in that he, in or around the period between January 2014 to June 2014,

- (a) failed to advise the Patient on the limitation of the pair of spectacles prior to her purchase of the spectacles; and/or
- (b) failed to take appropriate follow-up action after the Patient complained to him about the vision problems in wearing the glasses prescribed by him;

and that in relation to the facts alleged, either individually or accumulatively, he has been guilty of unprofessional conduct.

In accordance with section 22(1)(iv) of the Supplementary Medical Professions Ordinance (Chapter 359), the Optometrists Board ordered on 19 November 2015 that a warning letter be served on Mr. LAU Tak-ki and the order shall be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette.
