ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN OIL STREET, NORTH POINT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 22 January 2016 to 6.00 p.m. on 22 July 2016, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Oil Street from a point about 40 metres north of its junction with King Wah Road to its end; and
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Oil Street from its end to a point about 10 metres north of its junction with King Wah Road.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
