ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN YAU MA TEL

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 19 March 2016 to 5 Arpil 2016, the following road sections in Yau Ma Tei will continue to be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Man Yuen Street from its junction with Ferry Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Ferry Street from its junction with Man Yuen Street to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
