ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN NORTH POINT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 March 2016, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Healthy Street Central from a point about 20 metres south of its junction with Tsat Tsz Mui Road to the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Healthy Street Central from its junction with Pak Fuk Road to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Tsat Tsz Mui Road from its junction with Healthy Street Central to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction; and
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Pak Fuk Road from a point about 15 metres west of its junction with Healthy Street Central to the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
