ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN SHEUNG WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 March 2016, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Queen's Street from a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Ko Shing Street to a point about 40 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the southen kerbside lane of Ko Shing Street from a point about 20 metres west of its junction with Queen's Street to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the southen kerbside lane of Ko Shing Street from a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Queen's Street to a point about 50 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
