

## PUBLIC ORDER ORDINANCE (Chapter 245)

## FRONTIER CLOSED AREA—PERMISSION TO ENTER

Pursuant to section 38A(1) of the Public Order Ordinance and without prejudice to the provisions of any other Ordinance, persons within the category of persons specified in the second column of the Schedule are, for the purposes of the Public Order Ordinance, permitted to enter or leave the Frontier Closed Area during the dates and times specified in relation thereto in the third column of the Schedule, subject to the conditions specified in the fourth column of the Schedule.

In this notice 'the Frontier Closed Area' means the area specified in the Schedule to the Frontier Closed Area Order.
