ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITED ZONES FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING 3.5 METRES IN HEIGHT IN WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 5, 7, 11 and 12 April 2016 and from 12.01 a.m. to 6.00 a.m. on 1 and 14 April 2016, the section of Marsh Road northbound between Lockhart Road and Gloucester Road service road, and the section of Jaffe Road between Tonnochy Road and Marsh Road will be temporarily designated as prohibited zones for vehicles exceeding 3.5 metres in height.

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving vehicles exceeding 3.5 metres in height into the above prohibited zones.

The extent of the prohibited zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.
