ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN WONG CHUK HANG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 3 April 2016, the following road sections in Wong Chuk Hang will be designated restricted zones at the time specified below:—

24 hours daily

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Yip Kan Street northbound from its eastern junction with Wong Chuk Hang Road to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound between its eastern junction with Yip Kan Street and Tong Bin Lane; and
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Tong Bin Lane from its junction with Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction.

from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily

- (a) the section of Tong Bin Lane southbound between Wong Chuk Hang Road and Yip Kan Street; and
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound from its junction with Tong Bin Lane to a point about 60 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
