## EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI YIP STREET, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 9 April 2016 to 6 May 2016, the following road sections in Tai Yip Street will continue to be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Tai Yip Street from a point about 130 metres south of its junction with Hong Tak Road to a point about 180 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Tai Yip Street from a point about 20 metres south of its junction with Hong Tak Road to a point about 80 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Tai Yip Street from a point about 50 metres south of its junction with Hong Tak Road to a point about 80 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

(a) picking up or setting down passengers; or

(b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
