ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN MAN TAI STREET, HUNG HOM

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 23 April 2016 to 4 September 2016, the following sections of Man Tai Street will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones at the periods as specified below to facilitate the construction of MTRCL Kwun Tong Line Extension:—

24 hours daily

- (a) the section of Man Tai Street from its junction with Hung Hom Road to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction (excluding parking spaces); and
- (b) the section of Man Tai Street from a point about 90 metres west of its junction with Hung Hom Road to its junction with Tak Man Street (excluding parking spaces and public light buses (scheduled services) stand).

From 8.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. and from 5.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily

(a) the section of Man Tai Street from a point about 30 metres west of its junction with Hung Hom Road to a point about 90 metres west of the same junction (excluding parking spaces).

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be continue to temporarily rescinded.
