

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

KWUN TONG LINE EXTENSION

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WUHU STREET TEMPORARY PLAYGROUND,
FAT KWONG STREET PLAYGROUND, A STAIRCASE NEAR
THE JUNCTION OF FAT KWONG STREET AND CHUNG HAU STREET, AND
SECTIONS OF FAT KWONG STREET AND SHEUNG LOK STREET**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 8 June 2016 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary closure of Wuhu Street Temporary Playground, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered KTE/G03/0002/5;
- (II) the temporary closure of Fat Kwong Street Playground, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered KTE/G03/0002/5;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the staircase near the junction of Fat Kwong Street and Chung Hau Street, as delineated and shown in light green on the Plans numbered KTE/G03/0002/5 and KTE/G07/0005/6; and
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of the section of Fat Kwong Street between a point about 30 metres north of its junction with Sheung Lok Street and a point about 110 metres south of the junction, and the section of Sheung Lok Street between its junction with Fat Kwong Street and a point about 220 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow and dark blue respectively on the Plan numbered KTE/G07/0005/6,

during the period from 1 July to 30 September 2016 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Kwun Tong Line Extension. A description of the works to be carried out, the areas of Wuhu Street Temporary Playground and Fat Kwong Street Playground, the staircase and the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered KTE/G03/0002/5 and KTE/G07/0005/6 (the 'Plans') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near Wuhu Street Temporary Playground, Fat Kwong Street Playground, the staircase and the roads affected by the Order on 17 June 2016.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of Wuhu Street Temporary Playground, Fat Kwong Street Playground, the staircase and the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of Wuhu Street Temporary Playground, Fat Kwong Street Playground, the staircase and the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of Wuhu Street Temporary Playground, Fat Kwong Street Playground, the staircase and the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

| (d) The section of Fat Kwong Street between a point about 30 metres north of its junction with Sheung Lok Street and a point about 110 metres south of the junction, and the section of Sheung Lok Street between its junction with Fat Kwong Street and a point about 220 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow and dark blue respectively on the Plan numbered KTE/G07/0005/6. | Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the covered walkway, the footbridge and the associated structures of the Kwun Tong Line Extension, and reinstatement works. |
